	A pronoun that takes the place of (replaces) a noun
<i>reflexive</i>	
	A pronoun used in order to ask a question. Some of them refer only to people, like "who" and others refer to people and objects, etc like "what". They do not distinguish between singular and plural, so they only have one form.
<i>possessive</i>	
	Words that replace nouns but do not specifically identify the noun that they are replacing. <i>Anybody, nothing, many, all</i> and <i>several</i> are some examples
